

Minutes ASTA MD/DC Annual Membership Meeting, May 17, 2009

4. Cathy Stewart explained a three-year plan made with rock violinist Mark Wood, director of the Trans-Siberian Orchestra. In 2011 his visit would involve the public and private school students as well, and in 2012 would culminate in a performance of local students with his orchestra in the MCI center. 5. President's report: The board members have increased this year. We have established links with University of Maryland education program. Doree has been trying to make progress on drawing in MMEA and public school string teachers.
