- 2:30-4:00 p.m. – Optional high school excerpts workshop

Classes for cello students from elementary through high school will be taught by some of Arizona's finest and most experienced university, public school and studio cello teachers. Some of the highlights of the day will include:

Beginning to Advanced Classes: Classes are structured for all ages and playing levels, from Beginner Level 1 through Advanced Level 5 (see reverse side for details concerning requirements for each level). Music and other materials will be provided in the classes. Level 4 and 5 students will be taught by Thomas Landschoot, Cello Professor at ASU, and Debra Pearson, principal of the Arizona Opera, and are encouraged to bring solos and other music they are working on.

Lunch will be provided to all registrants.

Concert Performance: All cellists will be learning cello ensemble music in their respective classes and will perform them onstage in a free concert before an audience of family and friends. Thomas Landschoot and ASU cellists will perform on this concert.

Optional Regional/All-State Excerpts Workshop: This optional workshop for interested high school students will be held from 2:30 – 4:00 p.m. and will cover the orchestral excerpts for this year's auditions. The workshop will be taught by a professional performing cellist.

Celobration T-Shirts and other memorabilia will be available for purchase.

The Music Store of Mesa and Andrew's Fine Violins will have selections of instruments, cello music, rosin, strings, metronomes, etc., on display and available for purchase. Students who are interested in purchasing any materials should bring extra money for this purpose.

Teachers: Certification Verification will be available for any teacher who attends any of the classes. Pre-registration is recommended; however, there is no registration charge for teachers.

Parents: Parents are welcome to observe the class their young cellist is attending.

Cost: \$20 if postmarked by Nov. 13; \$30 if after that date. You may also register on the day of the event (please arrive by 8:00 a.m.). Fee includes morning snack and pizza lunch.

Students must bring: cello and bow, rosin, endpin strap and two pencils
