

Ms. Dettwiler is the Orchestra Director at Cape Henry Collegiate School and former adjunct professor of Strings Techniques and String Quartet at Christopher Newport University. A graduate of Wilfrid Laurier University in Waterloo, Ontario, Canada and University of Western Ontario, she holds an Honors Bachelor of Music Education and graduate degree in Education. Former principal cellist of the Waterloo Chamber Players and full time educator, she brings many years of performing, recording and teaching experience as a new member to the Hampton Roads musical community. Ms. Dettwiler performs as a freelance cellist with the Virginia Arts Festival (Catch the Wave), Cantata Chorus, CNU orchestra, Williamsburg Trio, Old Dominion University's professional contemporary ensemble CREO, among others, and numerous chamber and solo works. She has served as an adjudicator for several festivals in Norfolk, Virginia Beach and Newport News, and has been a three-time invited guest conductor for the All-City Orchestra Festivals. Ms. Dettwiler is currently a performing cellist for Symphonicity, Millennium Symphony (recording orchestra) and Spumoni Strings. National and International CD releases include Dean Shostak on Glass Armonica, Music of the Grand Salon and Made in the Americas with the Millennium Symphony. Concert tours include Prague, Vienna, Olomouc, Guantanamo Bay, New York, Paris and London. She has a thriving private studio in Norfolk, and serves as a mentor/ assistant conductor for the Virginia Youth Symphony Orchestra.
